



COBRA Premium Subsidy No Longer Available for Involuntary Terminations that Occur after May 31, 2010

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The American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) provides a COBRA premium subsidy for eligible individuals who are involuntarily terminated from employment through the end of May 2010. Because Congress has chosen not to grant an extension, the COBRA premium subsidy under ARRA is not available for individuals who experience involuntary terminations after May 31, 2010. As a result, the prior model notices (non-ARRA) have gone back into effect.
